1. Welcome and approval of Agenda

President Siroos Mirzaei (SM) opens the meeting. The agenda is approved.

2. News of the UEMS/EBNM President

SM introduces the Executive Board Members and Committee Members Ariane Boubaker, Zehra Özcan, Roland Hustinx, Mohsen Farsad and John Prior.

EACCME 2.1.

S. Mirzaei reports about the EACCME Meeting which took place from March 11-12, 2022 in Sevilla, Spain. One major outcomes of the meeting are a new accreditation module which is microlearning (accreditation of 30 minute lectures). Further topics addresses were LEE vs Hybrid Sessions, Event assessment and reading scientific peer-review.

Clinical Audit Session

SM presents the clinical audit session which will be held on October 17, 2022 at 08:00 during EANM'22.

J. Prior is asking the national delegate for help (translation) when receiving the documents for clinical audits/accreditation.

3. Finances 2021

Roland Hustinx (RH) presents the 2021 financial numbers. The member countries call for contribution brought in an amount of 10.500€ during the COVID year. Overall, the NM section collected a plus of 32.697,81€ and RH also expects a positive balance for 2022. EACCME Reimbursement fees from 2019 have been received. Due to Covid Times, EBNM had no meeting costs (no travel expenses) The total expenses add up to 27580,01. EBNM has a positive balance of EUR 5.117,80

R. Hustinx thanks the internal auditor Rainer Lipp for approving the income.

4. Election

14 votes: 100% in favour

S. Mirzaei is elected the new president for 2023-2026.

5. Committee Business – news/prospects of the future

a. Fellowship Examination Committee – FEBNM

Z. Özcan reports about the past FEBNM exams during the last 2 years. In 2021 the oral examination has been held completely electronically. The committee has met in Vienna whereas the participants were connected live through the internet. In 2022, 47 participants attended the online MCQs, 19 participants attended the oral examination. Z. Özcan is approaching the Delegates to motivate Fellows from Europe to attend FEBNM. Z. Özcan thanks the Committee and the office.

D. Huic reports that the FEBNM exam is officially recognized in Croatia.

b. Education and Syllabus Committee

The Syllabus needs to be updated as a revision need to be done every 5 years. The last revision took place in 2017. 3 Options have been identified:

- Work on the current document
- Update the current document & replace appendix with updated NM Guide
- Comprehensive ETRs & Syllabus with EANM

For option 2 and 3 the cooperation of EANM is needed. R. Hustinx is pointing out that option 2 and 3 will need a lot of involvement. Option 3 is seen as too complex. EANM Committees will be involved when choosing option 2 or 3. S. Mirzaei is raising the question whether the syllabus will be automatically updated when the NM Guide will be updated in 2 years.

c. CME Accreditation Committee (CME credits are mandatory for events requested under the auspices of the EANM)

M. Farsad is reporting about the new criteria which will be implemented in March 2023. In most countries, CME activities are mandatory. All EACCME accredited events must be free of commercial bias and shall be published on the EACCME platform.
